Eligibility Requirements

ELDERLY HOUSING & FAMILY HOUSING

AGE: Must be 60 years of age or disabled to apply for elderly housing. We require a physician's statement if the individual is under 60 years of age. The South Hadley Housing Authority will forward a Physician's Statement to you at your request or upon review of the application to determine eligibility.

INCOME: Net income limits by household size for determining admission for state aided programs:

<u>One</u>	<u>Two</u>	<u>Three</u>	<u>Four</u>	<u>Five</u>
\$46,000	\$52,600	\$59,150	\$65,700	\$71,000

ASSETS: No Limit

- 1st Homeless due to natural forces
- 2nd Homeless due to Public Action (Public Works)
- 3rd Homeless due to Public Action (Public Health)
- 4th Emergency as defined in the South Hadley Housing Authority Emergency Case Plan.
- 5th AHVP Participant and applicant, otherwise eligible and qualified, who is living in a non- permanent transitional housing subsidized by the AHVP.
- 6th Transfer for good cause
- 7th Standard application

To receive consideration for Priorities 1 thru 5, documentation must be included at the time of the application. An emergency application will be forwarded at the applicant's request. If there is not proper documentation, the priority will not be given and the application will be assigned to a priority 7 (standard application).
